petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is expected to honour
his undertaking given in the instant case for depositing the
requisite court fee and to remove the defects as pointed out by
the office when called upon to do so by the office.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323,
504, 324, 308/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault to the informant by the accused
persons along with this petitioner. It is submitted that petitioner
is father-in-law of the informant. From perusal of the impugned
order, it is mentioned that injured had sustained simple injury.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 571/2021, corresponding to G.R. No. 1786/2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
