2 03-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel for the Vigilance.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection
with Garhpura P.S. Case No. 54 of 2020 registered for the
offence punishable under sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 120B
of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this
case merely on basis of suspicion. Petitioner has not
committed any fraud. Certificate was granted to the
petitioner by the competent authority and it is not forged.
Petitioner's father name is Hare Singh and not Ramkant

Prasad Singh as is evident from the Admit Card annexed as Annexure-2. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Garhpura P.S. Case No. 54 of 2020 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
