3 15-12-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(i) For issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus commanding and directing the respondents authority the date of submission of E- Tender in view of the letter issued by the Nodal officer E-Tendering, State of Bihar considering that on the date of last submission of form the server was down and petitioner including others could no submit E-Tender.

(ii) For further quashing of the letter No-1730 dated 09.07.2019 issued by the Executive Engineer PHED division, Muzaffarpur despite of letter dated 08.07.2019



issued by Nodal Officer E-Tendering has not extended the date of E-Tender.

(ii) And for any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is found to be entitled in the eye of law.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instruction, states that, in view of the intervening developments, the present petition has become infructuous. As such, petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

Prayer allowed.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
