2 21-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief :-

*“(i) For issuance of direction/ directions
upon the respondent authorities to restore
back the peaceful possession of the petitioner
over “Bharat Jalpaj” situated at Chhoti
Sariyaganj, Muzaffarpur, by open the lock of
the said shop, which was illegally locked by
respondent no. 6 by ignoring the law laid
down under Bihar Buildings (Lease, Rent &
Eviction) Control Act, 1982”*

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the



petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies, as are available under the law. Liberty so sought, is granted.
