2 18-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of about 8 liters of country
made wine from one co-accused Devendra Das.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that the name of the petitioner was disclosed by
apprehended co-accused Devendra Das and nothing
incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious or
constructive possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got clean



antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Sitamarhi in connection with Bajpatti P.S. Case No. 77 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
