ORAL ORDER

3 25-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is in judicial custody in connection
with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 135 of 2021, registered under
Sections 366/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner and other accused
persons are of kidnapping the sister of the informant and later
on demand of Rs. 10,000/- for her release.

From perusal of learned Sessions Judge order, it
shows that subsequently the victim girl was recovered and she
made statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. wherein she
specifically named this petitioner who forcefully made physical
relationship with her inside the room while three other accused
persons were guarding the room.



Taking into account the aforesaid facts that specific allegation has been made against this petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner herein, which is accordingly rejected.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial and take the same to its logical conclusion at an earliest.
