2 17-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video
conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in a case registered under section 30 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 190 bottles of cough
syrup was recovered from possession of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case.
Neither any incriminating article has been recovered from his
possession nor has he any concern with the alleged recovery. He
is in custody since 28.7.2021 and has no criminal antecedent.
Charge sheet has been submitted in the case.

Heard learned APP for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case specially the petitioner not having any criminal antecedent, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Special Excise Case no. 588 of 2021 (arising out of Jogbani P.S. Case no. 150 of 2021) on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Araria.
