The petitioner has filed an election petition as has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner.

This Court, exercising writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is not required to entertain the nature of relief which the petitioner is raising in the background



of an election dispute.

This application, in our view, deserves to be dismissed
