The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Baghaila P.S. Case No. 03/2020 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 498(A)/304(B)/201/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Considered the submissions of the petitioners and also
considered the medical records of treatment of the deceased in
B.H.U. annexed with the case diary.

It has also been submitted that the deceased has a
three years old child who is residing with the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present anticipatory bail



application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of ten weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram, Rohtas, in connection with Baghaila P.S. Case No. 03/2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
