Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“That in this writ application the petitioner prays for issuance of writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 15/04/2019 contained in letter no. C/67/19 as contained in annexure 9 passed by respondent no 3 by which the claim of the petitioner was rejected and was denied payment of bill dated 06/04/2015 as contained in annexure 3 which was for supply of computer assistant, peon, gunman, providing the college of respondent authorities for the period April 2014-15.

That the petitioner further prays for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents authorities to make the payment of bill dated 06/04/2015 as contained annexure 3 series which



was for supply of computer assistance, peon, sweeper, gunman and security guard provide in the college of the respondent authorities for the period April 2014-15.

That the petitioner further prays for issuance of writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions in his favor in the fact and circumstances of this case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition, on the same and subsequent cause of action; raising additional grounds and placing on record additional material.
