This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Jalley P.S. Case No. 117 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 409 & 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner, after registering a Nidhi Company, has cheated Rs. 62 - 65 lakhs from general public and on maturity, when the money was demanded by the investors, the petitioner fled away.

In the opinion of this Court, this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed.



The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of two weeks from today. If the petitioner does not surrender within the aforesaid period of two weeks then, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna, will take all steps for arresting the petitioner.
