ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 380/456 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant suspects that all the F.I.R. named accused persons including this petitioner have stolen his buffalo.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner has been made accused in this case only on suspicion. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

However, learned counsel for the informant has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, in



the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria P.S. Case No. 667 of 2021, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
