the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection

with Mahila Banka P.S. Case No. 28 of 2021 registered for the

offence punishable under sections 498A/34 of the Indian

Penal Code and sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners

submits that petitioners have committed no offence as

alleged in the first information report and they have been

falsely implicated in this case merely because they are the

relatives of the husband of the informant. Nothing specific is

alleged against the petitioners. Petitioners have clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Mahila Banka P.S.Case No. 28 of 2021 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
