2 22-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Section 307, 379 and some
other ancillary Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, all the FIR named
accused persons including these petitioners assaulted the
informant and his parents as a result of which they sustained
injuries.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits
that petitioner are innocent and have falsely been implicated in
the case. Allegation of assault is general and omnibus. On



account of petty dispute the scuffle took place. Injuries caused by the petitioners are found to be simple in nature. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts of the case, nature of accusation and clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Biraul, Darbhanga in connection with Ghanshyampur PS case No. 67/ 2022, subject to conditions laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr. P. C.
