2 22-03-2022 Learned counsel for the parties have addressed us at considerable length. We, however, feel that if the petitioner has grievance, he has no option but to move an application for impleadment before the DRT.

If such an application is moved by the petitioner, the same shall be entertained by the DRT considering that his presence before it may be necessary to completely and effectually adjudicate upon the issue.



Needless to observe that if grouse of the petitioner continues, he shall be at liberty to approach the higher forum, such as DRAT.

The petition stands disposed of as not pressed, however on the aforesaid terms.
