Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to
remove the defects within three weeks.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 149,
448, 341, 323, 307 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this
case. He submits that there is there is case and counter case



between the parties. He submits that after investigation Police has filed final form against the petitioners but learned Court below differed the final form and taken cognizance against the petitioner. He submits that informant and petitioner's father are cousin brother. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Goh P.S. Case No. 85/2015, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
