2 22-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 307 & other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, these petitioners are alleged to have assaulted the staff of the informant.

Doctor has found simple injury. Case and counter case. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let



the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Gaya in connection with Tekari P.S. Case No. 256 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
