ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2022 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, all the FIR named accused persons including the petitioners have indiscriminately assaulted the informant's side by means of various weapons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such



occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation leveled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. It is submitted that there is a case and counter-case between the parties. He further submits that both sides have sustained grievous injuries. Petitioner no.1 and 3 have one criminal antecedent and petitioner no.2 have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as both sides have sustained grievous injuries, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Lauriya P.S. Case No.171 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
