2 23-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

As per allegation, the petitioners and other co-caused having pistol came at the place of occurrence and Kallu @ Md. Niyaz started firing which caused injury to Md. Amzad.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that no specific overt-act has been alleged against the petitioners and the petitioners claim clean antecedent.



Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest/ surrender within four weeks from today, let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheikhpura in Sheikhpura P. S. Case no. 429 of 2021 subject to condition as laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
