2 13-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 393 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of robbery of the vehicle of the informant by the accused persons including the petitioner on the gun point

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the name of the petitioner figured on the basis of confessional statement of apprehended co-accused Jogesh Kumar and petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Danapur in connection with Paliganj P.S. Case No. 55 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
