As per the F.I.R., some unknown miscreants, on the point of gun, looted the Scorpio of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that name of the petitioner has come during course of investigation on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Sanjeet Kumar. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner and till date, he has not been put on T.I.P. Petitioner is in custody since 03.09.2021.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the bail petition of petitioner is allowed. Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Rafiganj P.S. Case No. 262 of 2021.
