3 22-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Jogbani P.S. Case No.119 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner No.1, Ganga Prasad Yadav is said to have assaulted the informant by means of iron rod on his head and Petitioner No.2, Dipendra Yadav is said to have assaulted the informant by means of iron rod causing fracture injury in his left hand. It is also alleged that petitioner no.1 assaulted the father of the informant by means of sharp edged weapon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the



petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. It is submitted that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail application. It is further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties and both sides sustained injuries.

The learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Taking into consideration the facts that there is case and counter case between the parties and both sides sustained injuries, let petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-Vth, Araria in connection with Jogbani P.S. Case No.119 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
