communication of a copy of this order. Before disposing of the representation, the petitioner shall be heard and a reasoned order shall be passed in accordance with law. Till final disposal of the representation of the petitioner, status quo over the land in question shall be maintained.

This writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
