APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Danapur RPF Post P.S. Case no. 551 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 145, 146, 147, 153(B) and 174(B) of the Railway Act.

As per allegation in the FIR, while Train No. 03202 Down was coming, a motorcycle bearing Registration No. BR01BU-5790 was passing by Danapur railway crossing and on seeing the train close to him, he dropped his motorcycle there and fled away due to which his motorcycle got damaged and driver of train had used emergency break to avoid any accident.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner



has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. No one has seen the petitioner at the place of occurrence. Except the ownership of the alleged vehicle, nothing is against the petitioner.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Danapur RPF Post P.S. Case no. 551 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Arrah subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
