ORAL ORDER

2 09-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

Allegation is of recovery of 270 litres of liquor from a
red colour Hyundai car and 90 litres of liquor from a nearby
premise at the place of occurrence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession. It is further submitted



that petitioner came to be implicated as he is the owner of the Hyundai car. It is also submitted that petitioner's car was missing since 21.05.2022 and no prudent man would use his own vehicle for committing a crime and thus creating evidence against himself.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bhaptiyahi P.S. Case No. 57 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
