Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

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1. That this Public Interest Litigation is being filed for issuance of appropriate writ, rule, direction commanding upon the respondent Cabinet Vigilance Department to investigate in the financial irregularities committed by the Vice Chancellor of Magadh University namely Dr. Prof. Rajendra Prasad in issuing purchase orders for the University without floating any tender as also for making appointments without following the due procedure established under statutes for such appointments.

And/Or

for any other order(s), direction(s) which may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

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From the affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents, it is evidently clear that action against the erring officers/officials stands initiated and First Information Report stands registered by the Special Vigilance Unit as Police Station Case No. 02 of 2021 dated 16.11.2021 for the offences under Sections 120(B)/420 of the Indian Penal Code as also the provisions of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
