Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“That this application is directed for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari/ any other appropriate writ/ order/ direction for quashing the letter dated 3.3. 2019 issued to the petitioner and the letter dated 20.6.19 issued Under RTI Act by which the case of the petitioner has been placed Under group 3 for Consideration for allotment of Retail outlet Dealership on N.H. 84, District Bhojpur 3 K.M. of either side from Amrai Nawada



School.

At the very outset it is stated that the petitioner has filled up his online application for petrol Pump and has submitted documents concerning the ownership of the land proposed to be use for establishment of petrol pump as per the criteria mentioned in group -1, but the respondents have placed the case of the petitioner under Group-3 for the purpose of consideration.”
