2 01-02-2022 Petitioner has prayed for following relief(s) :-

“That the present writ petition is being filed on behalf of the petitioner for release of or refund of Rs.2,92,313/- the (Rupees Two Lacs Ninety Two Thousand and Three Hundred Thirteen) only deposited by the petitioner against the release of his vehicle bearing Registration no. GJ 12Y 5273 and for further order/orders, direction/directions to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 15.11.2021 and



for other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner in the facts and circumstances of the case may entitle to.”

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Bench not to be in favour of the submission so made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petition may be permitted to be withdrawn reserving liberty to challenge the intervening developments before the appropriate forum.

Prayer allowed.

Liberty reserved to the petitioner to take recourse to such other remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
