APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Narpatganj P.S. Case no.161/2020 instituted for the offence under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioners along with their other family members have tortured in various ways due to non-fulfillment dowry demand and ultimately they killed her.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are relatives of the husband of the



deceased. They have been falsely implicated in this case. They have never demanded any thing from the deceased. They have no concern with the daily activity of the deceased and her husband. They are living separately. The sole responsibility to take care of wife is upon husband and not against his family members. It is further submitted that husband is languishing in judicial custody.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Narpatganj P.S. Case no. 161/2020, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Araria subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
