2 28-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 307 and some other ancillary Sections of the Indian Penal Code and u/s 27 of Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner along with other FIR named accused persons made indiscriminate firing but no one has sustained any injury.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the case. It is submitted that no specific overt act has been alleged against this petitioner and in the so called indiscriminate firing nobody received any injury. Petitioner is in custody since 13.09.2021 and investigation in this case is complete.



Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of the case and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Barh, Patna in connection with Bakhtiyarpur PS case No.93/2021.
