named in this case merely on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused and except for that there is no material against the petitioners.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners submitting that the petitioners are having criminal antecedent and their names transpired in the confessional statement of the co-accused for their involvement in the occurrence as stated in the F.I.R.

Having regard to the submissions made hereinabove and considering the fact that no Test Identification Parade has been conducted and nothing incriminating has been recovered from the petitioners and further considering the period of custody, the petitioners above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-1st (West), Muzaffarpur in connection with Shebganj P.S. Case No. 222 of 2021, subject to the following conditions :

(i) The bail bond of the petitioners shall be accepted only after framing of charge, if not already framed.

(ii) One of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioners.



(iii) The petitioners will remain present on each and every day fixed by the court below.

(iv) In case of absence for three consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, the bail bond of the petitioners will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
