The petitioner seeks bail in connection with L.N.M.U.
P.S. case No.252/2018, S.Tr. No.376 of 2019 registered under
Sections 302, 120(B), 34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in
the court of Additional Sessions Judge V, Darbhanga.



The earlier bail application of the petitioner was rejected vide Annexure 1 to the present application taking into account that the petitioner is the assailant.

A report was called for from the trial court. It has been reported that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined in this case and the case has been fixed for argument.

Considering the nature of accusation and the stage of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is rejected.

The Trial Court is directed to take all necessary steps to conclude the trial at the earliest.
