before Corona time senior citizen traveller have granted railway concession 40 and 50% less than ticket fare then due to mala fide intention by the railway authorities the said facilities has been ceased however, the senior citizen of India is entitled for such railway facility.

Petitioner further prays for any other and further relief/reliefs to which the senior citizen of India is entitled too.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, reserving liberty to take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
