2 03-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 363, 366(A), 504, 506/34
of the Indian Penal Code and u/s 4 of POCSO Act.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner along with
other accused persons kidnapped the daughter of informant.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
case. The victim in her statement u/s 164 of the Cr. P. C. has
stated that she was in love with this petitioner and has
solemnized marriage with him out of her own free will. The
victim stated her age to be 20 years. Petitioner is in custody
since 30.11.2020 and investigation in this case is complete.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of the case, the statement of victim recorded u/s 164 of the Cr. P. C. and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum- Special Judge, Katihar in connection with Mahila PS case No.04/2020.
