2 06-12-2022 The writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

*“1. That this writ application is being filed for
issuance of an appropriate writ/writs,
order/orders, direction/directions and
commanding the respondents to register the sale
deed dated 16.08.2011 which was executed in
favor of the petitioner by the private respondent.
It is further prayed that the appellate order
passed by the Collector, Madhepura in
Registration Appeal No. 1/2012 dated*



05.11.2018 as well as the order dated 26.12.2011 passed by the Registrar of Sub-Registry Office, Udakishunganj, Madhepura by which he has refused to register the sale deed also be quashed and pass such other order/orders, as your lordship may deem fit and proper.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
