2 20-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
308 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assault upon the informant due to which
the informant sustained injury.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners
that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that from perusal of the impugned order, it
appears that two injuries sustained were lacerated and abrasion
below right eye. Petitioners have got clean antecedent.



Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-X, Gaya in connection with Neemchak Bathani P.S. Case No. 130 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
