2 23-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

90.300 litres of illicit liquor has been recovered from
a tempo. One person was apprehended at the spot who disclosed
that the tempo belongs to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail
application. It is further submitted that there is no recovery from
the conscious possession of the petitioner.



Petitioner is agree to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) in the Patna High Court Legal Services Committee, Patna, bearing Account No.1413010060836, IFSC Code: PUNB0141320, Punjab National Bank, Bar Council Branch, Patna.

Taking into consideration the fact that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge-I, Excise Act, Darbhanga in connection with Keoti P.S. Case No.160 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the further conditions that:

(i) One of the bailors will be her own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or her husband.

(ii) The petitioner shall not indulge herself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned court below on showing receipt of deposit of the



aforesaid amount in the Patna High Court Legal Services
Committee, Patna.
