ORAL ORDER**

3 16-05-2022 Let the defects, as pointed out by the office, be removed within four weeks of starting of Court proceeding in physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 379 of the IPC.

The prosecution case, in short, is that on 06.12.2019, unknown miscreants snatched the purse containing passport, mobile , cash, ornaments etc. of the wife of the informant while she was travelling from Delhi to Howrah by Rajdhani Express.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that it appears from the FIR that the



date of occurrence was mentioned in the FIR as 05.12.2019 but the present FIR has been instituted on 09.12.2019 i.e. after four days of occurrence and there is no explanation of four days. He further submits that nothing has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner and the police, after investigation, submitted chargesheet against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2021.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submits that the petitioner carries nine more cases other than the present one

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No.428 of 2019, with the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the



witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
