ORAL ORDER

- 3 30-11-2022 Heard learned senior counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

In view of the counter-affidavit filed by the Superintendent of Police, the Court is *prima-facie* satisfied that it was mistake committed on part of the Investigating Officer who kept the charge-sheet with himself and submitted it later only few days before the present order was communicated to the learned trial court.

Since the order granting bail was clear that petitioners shall remain on anticipatory bail till filing of charge-sheet and now since charge-sheet has been submitted and the



Investigating Officer has been suspended and is being proceeded departmentally, as such the present modification application stands dismissed.
