(I) For a direction to the respondent Punjab National Bank to pay the money of Bank Saving Account No.2920001300031173 running in the Bank of Respondent no. 2, which is the account of deceased husband of the petitioner, in the Bank Account No.2920000108172833 of the petitioner, accepting the claim form filled up by the petitioner as per the instruction of the respondent no. 2, the Branch Manager, Punjab National Bank, Patna, because the petitioner is only legally entitled to get the money.



(II) For a direction to the Respondents to grant any other relief/ reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled in the fact and circumstances of the case.”
