2 26-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 148, 149,
341, 323, 333, 307, 353, 427, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is of obstruction in discharge of official
duty by the police personnel, the petitioner allegedly damaged
the police vehicle when attempting to assault the informant with
lathi.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
case. There is general and omnibus allegation against this
petitioner. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the
prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts of the case and clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with Islampur PS case No. 139/2020, subject to conditions laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr. P. C.
