2 29-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Magadh University P.S. Case No. 56 of 2018 registered under
Section 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of
the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further he submits that before
this occurrence, the petitioner has already sold his vehicle to one
Binu Kumar, for which he prepared agreement paper
(Annexure-2). Petitioner has no concern with the alleged vehicle
or recovered materials. Further he submits that petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya in connection with Magadh University P.S. Case No. 56 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
