2 29-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Excise P.S. Case No. 02 of 2021 registered under 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. From perusal of seizure list, it is
evident that the alleged recovery has been made from Manju
Devi. Petitioner has no concern with the recovered articles.
Further he submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 201 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
