2 19-07-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Dighalbank P.S. Case no. 50 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, over a dispute of grazing the maize by she-goat an scuffle took place. Petitioner has assaulted to Md. Kasim and Gaira by means of *farsa* resulting into their head injuries. Other co-accused have also assaulted to Md. Ataullah by giving knife blow into his neck as a result of which he sustained cut injury in neck.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner



has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He has got no criminal antecedent. From perusal of injury report of Md. Kasim and Gairahe, it reveals that both have sustained simple injury.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Dighalbank P.S. Case no. 50 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Kishanganj subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
