issued under the signature of Director Bihar Museum, Patna respondent no. 2 whereby and whereunder the petitioner has been directed to execute new agreement with the Executive Engineer, Building Construction Department, Patliputra Building Division, Patna within one month without assigning any reason, who has already entered with the petitioner into an agreement on 01.12.2018 (Annexure-3) for five years for providing facility Museum, management service to Bihar Museum, Patna and he is regularly performing work continuously as per agreement.
