Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has renewed his prayer for grant of bail in a case registered under sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The earlier application for bail of the petitioner was rejected vide order dated 22.4.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. no.65296 of 2021.

As per the prosecution case, 15 litres of liquor was recovered from the motorcycle in question and the petitioner was taken into custody.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He is in custody since 18.9.2021 and chargesheet has been submitted in the case.



Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the nature of allegation, the liberty granted in the earlier order of rejection dated 22.4.2022 and the petitioner having remained in custody for more than 1 year since 18.9.2021, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Gurua P.S. Case no.216 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya.
