ORAL ORDER

2 06-12-2022 The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ petition is being filed on behalf of the petitioner for issuance of an appropriate writ/order, direction to the authorities respondents for filing charge-sheet/Final Form under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case



No. 34/19 for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 409, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code registered on the basis of written report of Informant/Petitioner at an earliest since the investigation is pending for almost last three years and there is no headway in the investigation.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
