learned counsel for the State.

In compliance of the order of this Court dated
25.09.2018, passed in C.W.J.C. no. 10190 of 2018, the
Registrar, Veer Kunwar Singh University, Ara has passed an
order dated 06.07.2020, wherein a sum of Rs. 58,47,269/- has
been found payable to the petitioner and admittedly, the same
has also been paid to the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
