Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within
a period of three weeks from today on resumption of physical
mode.

The Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148,
149, 307 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of Arms Act.

As per the F.I.R., co-accused Niraj Kumar @ Kallu
fired at the son of the informant causing injury to him near left
eye and nose.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that



similarly situated co-accused person has already been granted bail by a coordinate bench of this court vide order dated 25.03.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 2815 of 2022. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The specific allegation of firing is against co-accused Niraj Kumar. No specific overt act has been alleged against this petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in connection with Pirbahore P.S. Case No. 193 of 2021, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
