APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of country made Mahua liquor.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to rivalry from the villagers. He further submits that there is no recovery from the conscious or constructive possession of the petitioner and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Second Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Lakhisarai, District- Lakhisarai in connection with Lakhisarai (Amhara) P.S. Case No. 50 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
